INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS OF ACCEPTED MANUSCRIPTS

The final version of your manuscript must comply with IEEE periodicals requirements for text and graphics processing. Detailed information regarding the format of your final submission can be found here:

To upload your final files, please log into your author center and click the "Awaiting Final Files" queue. Please only upload the requested files and please do not submit any files or forms via email, post, or fax.

In addition to uploading your files, please check that the author-supplied data, such as contact and co-author information in Step 3 of the final submission process, is correct and complete. Failure to enter complete author and co-author information in the designated area during uploading may result in publishing delays.

The following items are required before your paper is processed for publication. Please be sure that all files match the final version of your accepted manuscript (no further revisions are allowed from your last version of accepted manuscript), that each item in the list below is included, and that each file has a unique name. Once you upload your final submission, you will not be able to add or change your files.
